



Simple F major scale

Try this scale with different rhythmic patterns, as in Fish 'n' chips variation (p. 24).










Fingering chart

The cornet and trumpet are both similar to a bugle.

Each plays an identical pattern of notes when no valves are pressed down. Putting down one or more valves lengthens the tube and changes the pitch of the pattern.



When the patterns above are linked together, you can play all the chromatic notes:
