
Starting in 2020, all premium rosins from Cremona in America are made under the name CECILIA.

CECILIA is the patron saint of musicians as well as the name of my beloved mother who passed away in 2019.

This new era of CECILIA rosin from CiA is a tribute to my mother's loving life and celebrates another decade of CiA with musicians all over the world.

CECILIA Rosin Collection

4 formulas availabe for violin, viola and cello







Signature Formula is the new flagship formula of the CECILIA Rosin Collection which provides a unique bowing sensation when in contact with the string and a clearly defined reaction. This is the most significant new development in the latest CECILIA Rosin Collection for the most demanding musicians. It helps the bow to give rich, full and expressive tones without excessive bite.







SOLO is a long time popular formula with strong grip that gives a very stable bowing sensation. The formula focuses on providing maximum projection as well as clear articulation. It is also forgiving under high bow pressure on the strings without the sound cracking. However, some musicians may find more effort is needed to create sensitivity in soft passages.







A Piacere is a bit like SOLO but with slightly less projection power, aiming for more blended, refined sound than the SOLO. The sound is a bit warmer than the SOLO, and it also works particularly well with soft sticks.







Both SOLO and A Piacere work well on a wide range of repertoire.

Sanctus is formulated to provide more possibilities in the sound of stringed instruments. It takes a very delicate process to complete as a single cake of rosin with two formulas in separate forms. And the appearance of the rosin is truly unique and beautiful. The outer ring formula gives a silky smooth bowing experience with a focused sound on the strings, and the soft center formula kicks in when the player demands more power and gutsiness from their instrument.

Choice of rosin and string is very personal, and the same rosin can feel different in sound and bowing sensation depending on the various combinations of the instrument, the bow and the strings. The preference can also change while you continue to develop your skills and musicianship. I recommend you to take time and experience the broad range of options available to you until you find your ideal performance setup.


