Swanee was George Gershwin's first big song hit, written in 1919. It was first sung in a musical show at the Capitol Theater in New York, but not until Gershwin's friend Al Jolson heard this song and incorporated it into one of his shows, Sinbad, did the tune become a national favorite.

The recording sold two million records and the publisher sold a million copies of the sheet music. Lyrics are by Irving Caesar with whom Gershwin frequently collaborated in his early days as a composer. Gershwin had written many songs before Swanee, and had even composed a musical, but this song made him famous.
