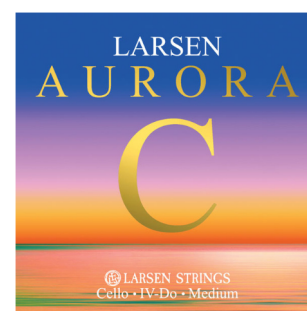
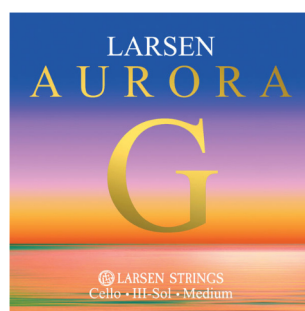
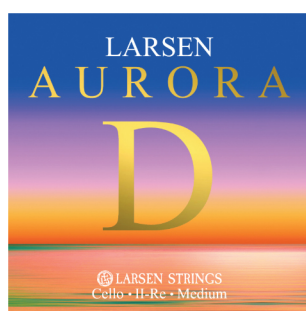
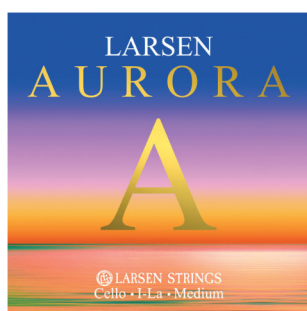
## Larsen Aurora Cello

### String Details

All four strings have a solid steel core. The A and D strings are wound with a corrosion resistant alloy, the G string with nickel, and finally the C string is made using tungsten.

The entire range offers an impressive string response and playing characteristic.
